## PROGRAM FORMAT

The PAGE Leadership Institute for 2010 STAR Teachers provides two one-day, high quality professional learning sessions focusing on significant and relevant topics that build upon the leadership skills of the STAR Teachers in Georgia. Each session is offered in regional locations on subsequent days and presented by the same national expert or consultant.

These institutes are FREE for all 2010 Georgia STAR TEACHERS and includes breakfast, lunch, and professional materials for use in the classroom. Schools must provide release time for their STAR Teacher to attend. Teachers may earn 1 PLU credit for participation and completion of both leadership sessions.

## GOALS

- Empower teachers with teaching strategies that have the greatest impact on student thinking and student success.
- Enhance the ability of teachers to validate and document learning no matter the time, place or source through the use of technology.

STAR Teachers will receive notification of this valuable training and must RSVP to the PAGE office to be included in the scheduled training.
